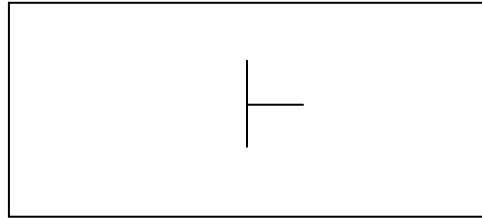

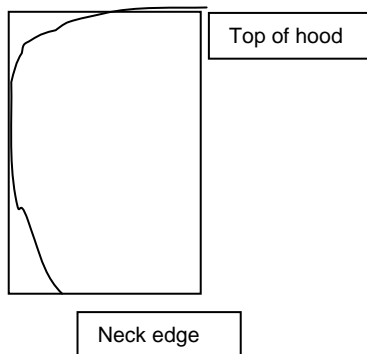
Fleece Poncho Instructions

Fleece fabric- 58 – 60”(This can be the width of fabric off the bolt) by 38”

Fold fabric in $\frac{1}{2}$ lengthwise to find center. Mark a line 12” across center. From the center of that line, mark 8” down to establish front. Slash open to form a 'T' for the opening.



For Hood- Cut two pieces of fabric 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” About 3 inches from one end, gently slop fabric edges to measure 6”- this will be the neck edge you will join to the poncho. Sew rounded edges together and turn seam allowance to inside. Finish seam edges.



Open out hood and sew the 12” lower edge to 12” neck opening on poncho. Finish raw edges with zigzag stitch. ***Make sure open edge of hood faces slit that is the front opening.*** Finish all edges with zigzag stitch including neck edge opening. Place two 1” size pieces of hook and loop tape (Velcro) other either side to close neck opening. Finish lower edge of poncho with serger or zigzag stitch.
