These cute little acorns were an easy sew. They can be used for coasters, make a garland, or toss on the table for decoration. What ever you decide to do with them will be great. I got these in a kit with easy instructions, but no kit or instructions are needed. Just draw an acorn cap and add the nut part. I used 2-1/2" squares for the nut portion and added the cap. Added fusible batting and quilted as desired then traced the acorn on batting side stitched on the traced line leaving an opening on the side to turn. Pressed them and stitched the opening closed. Well done with these cuties. Hope to see some in show and share.

Time to get the jackets out in preparation for the cooler weather. Do you have a favorite jacket pattern? I need to dig my jackets out to see if there are buttons needed to be replaced or if they need cleaned or if I need to redesign them into something that will be different.

October 13 meeting pattern for Tee Shirt we are going to sew our tee shirts at the October meeting!

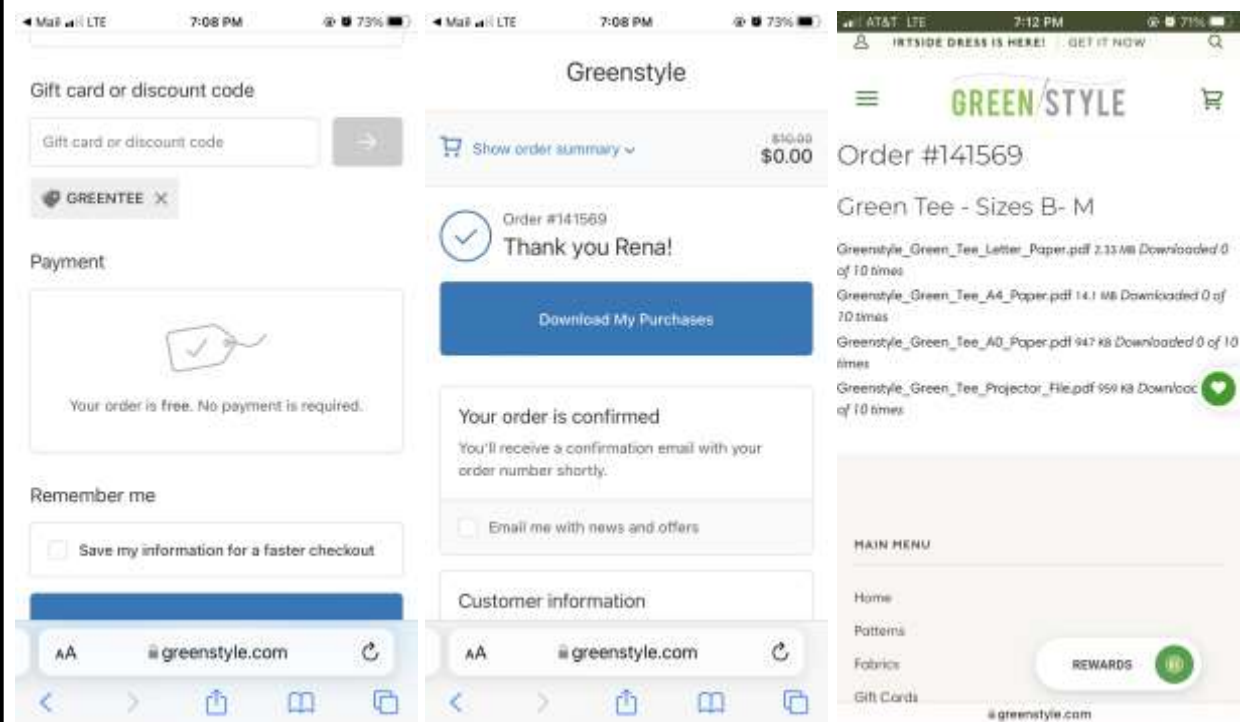
I contacted Angelyn and she said we could share patterns but she would prefer that people who could, register on her web site and download the free pattern.





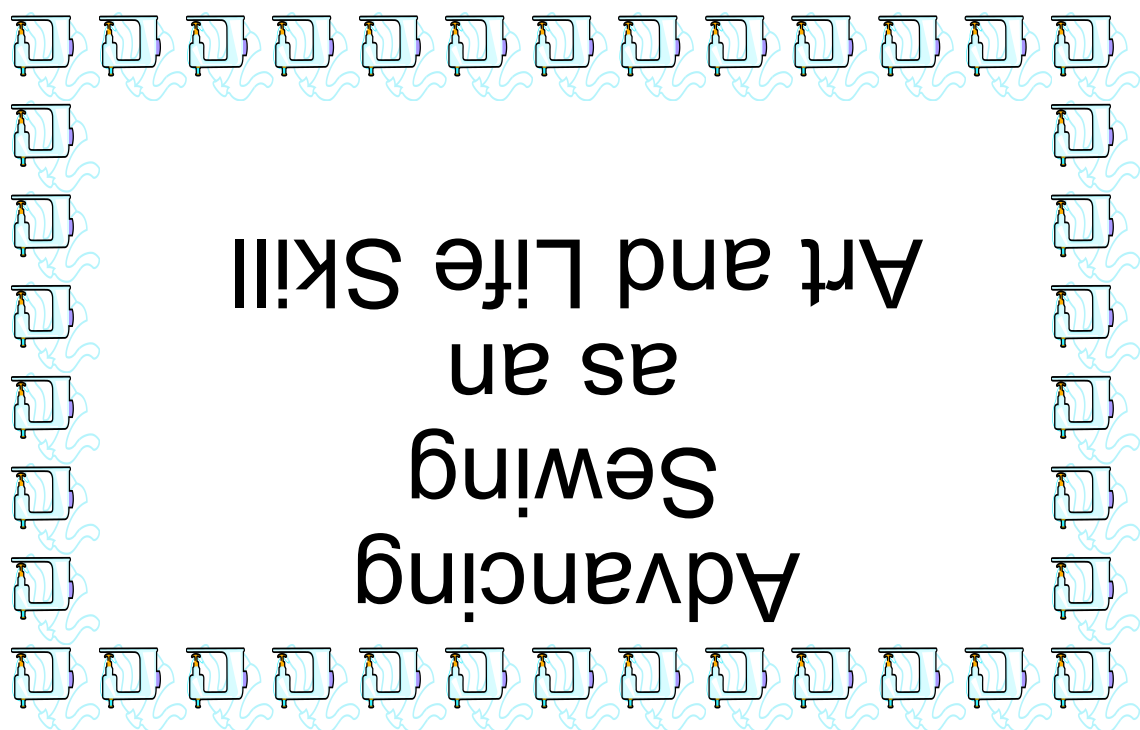
