

If you are interested in taking the leap to make a garment on the ASG Sew Day, August 20, Kerry McNutt will help you with the pattern Simplicity 1668- the jacket view that Kerry has made many times and shown at several meetings. (you should be able to purchase the pattern on sale) If you are unsure of the size to make, she can help you with pattern adjustments.

To make the jacket, please selected the suggested fabric such as a rayon, soft lightweight linen, jersey, knit, cotton interlocksomething that has drape and flow. Quilting cottons are not suited for this pattern. You will need a sewing machine to construct this jacket although serged seam finishes give it a very clean look.

Please make sure you have a good working knowledge of your machine. You should be able to complete this garment at the mini-retreat!"



ASG's 2017 Fabric Design Contest

You have seen it done on Project Runway, now it is your chance to design your own fabric in national's "Design Your ASG Fabric" contest.

For 2017, we are looking to have a national ASG fabric. So, what better way to get that fabric than to have our own members design it. So put on your thinking caps and let those creative juices start flowing. You can use photography, hand drawings, or computer generated drawings as long as it is your original work. The one requirement is that it must have the official ASG logo with the needle and thread featured somewhere in the design. The logo does not have to be the prominent feature, it just has to be included in the work. So if your fabric is made up of buttons, one of them could have the ASG logo. If your fabric features fashion drawings, one of the models could be wearing an ASG button. Or perhaps you are taking a



picture of your sewing notions, you might include the ASG tape measure with the logo among the items. Use your own creativity to design a fabric that we can print in both a knit and a cotton.

The designs should be submitted to ASG as an email attachment and sent to <u>asgfabricdesigncontest@gmail.com</u> by January 31, 2017. Emails should include the name of the designer as well as contact information such as phone number and preferred email address. All work must be original and will remain the property of the American Sewing Guild. Submissions should be completed and camera ready and not merely a sketch. Depending on the design, some modifications may be necessary by the fabric manufacturer.

All chapter presidents will be eligible to vote for the winning design in February, and the fabric will be on sale this spring. You may submit as many designs as you wish, but remember the deadline is January 31, 2017. We are looking forward to seeing all of your work! ASG Wichita Falls Chapter Sewing Retreat






